## Looking After Your Disposal Area

If you have an aerated wastewater treatment system (AWTS) or a septic tank, the wastewater will need to be disposed of onto a designated area of your property.

This area is often called a 'disposal area'. Maintaining your disposal area is essential to ensure that your septic system is well maintained. Here is a guide to looking after your disposal area:

## X DON'T

- ★ DON'T let children play in the absorption trench area
- ➤ DON'T drive over or disturb absorption trenches/effluent irrigation area
- X DON'T water fruit and vegetables with effluent
- DON'T build structures on the absorption trench or plant trees that will shade it
- X DON'T irrigate the area with water
- X DON'T drive cars on the disposal area

- ★ DON'T cover the disposal area with concrete or pavers
- DON'T store loads of soil or other materials on your absorption trench area
- DON'T place extra topsoil on top of your trench to 'soak up' a damp area
- DON'T extract untreated groundwater for cooking or drinking
- ➤ DON'T install or use a garbage grinder or spa bath if your system is not designed for it
